

Pasco County Schools' Employee Self-Screener (Last updated August 10, 2022)

The Pasco County School District expects all employees to complete this pre-entry self-screening tool daily before entering any school campus or district office location.

1. Do you have a new, or worsening, onset of any of the following symptoms?

- Fever (greater than 100.4) or chills
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- New uncontrolled cough (a change from your regular cough)
- Muscle or body aches
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Night Sweats

If **NO**, please continue to question no. 2.

If **YES**, you cannot come on campus. You are required to contact your worksite administrator/supervisor regarding your symptoms, and do ONE of the following:

- Provide your worksite documentation of a negative COVID-19 (antigen or PCR) test administered at home or a medical facility after the onset of symptoms.
 - While awaiting COVID testing results, you must remain off school/district campus in isolation.
 - If test result is **negative**, inform your administrator or supervisor and return to your work site.
 - If test result is **positive**, you cannot come on campus and are required to:
 - stay home for 5 days from the date the positive test was administered or stay home for at least 5 days since symptoms first appeared (whichever occurred first) **AND** be fever free for at least 24 hours (without fever reducing medicine) **AND** have improvement in other symptoms (cough, shortness of breath).
- Present a written clearance to return to work from your treating physician indicating an alternate diagnosis.
 - You must also be fever free for at least 24 hours (without taking medication to reduce fever) **AND** have improvement in other symptoms (cough, shortness of breath) prior to returning to work.

2. Have you tested positive within the last 5 days for COVID-19 or are waiting for test results due to your own illness?

If **NO**, you may come to work as planned.

If **YES**, you must remain home until your test results are available.

If test result is **negative**, then you can return to work.

If test result is **positive**, you cannot come on campus and are required to:

- Notify your administrator in order to plan your absence and return
- Stay home for 5 days from the date the positive test was administered or stay home for at least 5 days since symptoms first appeared (whichever occurred first) **AND** be fever free for at least 24 hours (without taking medication to reduce fever) **AND** have improvement in other symptoms (cough, shortness of breath).
